### 2024 SESSION BEGINS JANUARY 8

My work during our 60 days at the state Capitol will be focused in two directions. One involves the priorities of affordability, public safety, and K-12 education that are of concern to families and employers statewide. The second involves agriculture, tourism, water and other priorities specific to our 16th District and southeast Washington.

For instance, I plan to continue my efforts from this past session to get the state to honor its promise to control the price of fuel specifically for agricultural and maritime use. If we have to pass my legislation (**Senate Bill 5728**) to hold government accountable, and get the Department of Ecology to follow the law, I'm all in. Also, seeing how students across Washington have yet to recover learning opportunities lost to pandemic-driven classroom closures, I will continue promoting my bill (**SB 5024**) to help parents track what's going on in their local schools.

Many pieces of legislation will come before me in committees and on the floor of the Senate Chamber. Some will be simple changes in policy that are ready to become law. Other proposals will need a lot of work before they deserve passage, because of what they will mean for our communities. While I tend to take a conservative standpoint when introducing and considering legislation, I also recognize we're stronger when we work together. That's why I welcome other views from throughout our district, and from across the political aisle.
